Day 3: Mombasa Half Day City Tour

Step back in time with a visit to the iconic Fort Jesus Museum, where the group unravels the rich history and cultural heritage of Mombasa, gaining a deeper understanding of the local context.

You will be meet by our Mombasa representative and after a short brief, begin your Half Day City Tour where you will visit Fort Jesus, Old Town, Likoni Ferry and Fruit & Spice Market.



Fort Jesus is Mombasa's oldest museum and it depicts the culture and the origin of the local people, mentioning the origin of Swahili.



With a guide you will be able to trace the historical pattern leading to the influence of the sultans. In addition, you will learn the culture of the local people through different exhibitions. You will enjoy a walk-in narrow streets of the Mombasa old town, passing through the famous fish market before driving to see the elephant tusks as a monument of the ancient (now illegal) ivory trade.





You will be dropped off at a beach hotel where you will enjoy lunch, swimming at the pool and on the Ocean.

Plus spend time taking strolls along the white sandy beach in the evening.



Dinner is a grand feast, offering a tantalizing array of world-class flavors, blending the finest international cuisine with Swahili spices and coastal-inspired delicacies. Indulge in a gastronomic experience that celebrates the vibrant culinary heritage of the region.



Day 4: Haller Park

Stop At: Haller Park, North Coast of Mombasa along the Mombasa Malindi Road, Kenya.



After breakfast you will proceed to Haller Park.

This 165 sq/km Park hosts a variety of wildlife including: hippos, Rothschild giraffes, buffaloes, crocodiles, antelopes, water bucks, Vervet monkeys, monitor lizards, other smaller mammals and birds, numerous plant species, lily-covered ponds and a snake park. Its home to famous interspecies couple - the 130 years' old tortoise named Mzee ("Old" or "Old Man") who had adopted Owen, an orphaned baby hippo.





The land on which the Park is situated was once barren wasteland, a quarry where Bamburi Cement Company, mined coral limestone as a raw material for manufacturing cement, which was painstakingly rehabilitated by Dr Rene Haller.



The Park delivers more of a zoo-like experience than free-range park, but based on rehabilitated land.

Return to the hotel for lunch. In the afternoon you may engage in several hotel activities such as, water sports, swimming, boat rides, and snorkeling.

Dinner and overnight at the resort.

Day 5: Mombasa Marine National Park

Stop At: Mombasa Marine National Park, Nyali Rd, Mombasa, Kenya.



After breakfast, head to Mombasa Marine National Park for a boat ride on a glass bottomed boat whereupon you will be able to see a whole wide range of marine life and view the beautiful ocean life,

as well as enjoy scuba diving or snorkeling. The Marine Park is popular due to its accessibility, abundant marine life, crystalline blue waters and spectacular coral reefs.



Return to the resort for dinner and overnight

Day 6: Bombolulu Workshop and Cultural Centre

Stop At: Bombolulu Workshops, Mombasa, Kenya

After breakfast proceed to Bombolulu Workshop and Cultural Centre which a Project for the Association for the Physically Disabled in Kenya.



Guests can also purchase handcrafted souvenirs like wood carvings, textiles, jewelry, leather crafts, and tribal dance performances and explore traditional homesteads.





Day 7: Departing Mombasa

After a rejuvenating night's sleep, wake up to a final breakfast, savoring every bite while taking in the breathtaking ocean view one last time. Check out by 10 am.

You could opt for the following activities at own cost or take a beach stroll as you wait for the afternoon flights.

Unwind at one of Mombasa's renowned beaches, basking in the golden sun, and refreshing in the crystal-clear waters of the Indian Ocean.

At 1 pm, depart from Resort, the sun-kissed haven that has become a cherished home away from home. The memories created and the bonds formed during this exceptional retreat will forever be etched in the hearts and minds of all who participated in this extraordinary journey.
